

IABSE Member of the Year

1. Definition: The IABSE Member of the Year award shall be presented to an Individual Member of IABSE, for outstanding services rendered to the Association in the preceding year (such as contributions the National Group committees or boards and organization of conferences and events)

2. Nomination

Eligibility: Individual Member of IABSE.

Exception: Members of the Executive, Administrative and Technical Committees of IABSE are ineligible for election to the IABSE Member of the Year during their term of membership on these committees.

Frequency: irregular (maximum two per year)

Nomination's deadline: Prior to the Executive Committee Spring Meeting for the current year.

Nomination documents: Curriculum vitae (max 2 pages) and justification (max 1 page).

Nominations by: Executive, Administrative and Technical Committees, and National Groups.

3. Electing Body:

Executive Committee. Nominees considered from a shortlist prepared by the Awards Jury .

Examples of items to be considered by the jury:

- Activities in National Group;
- Activities in conference organizations;
- Activities in committees.

4. Presentation ceremony: at the ordinary Permanent Committee meeting or in conjunction with a Congress or Symposium, the President of IABSE shall present the IABSE Member of the Year with a Certificate titled "*For outstanding services rendered to IABSE*".

5. Privileges: The IABSE Member of the Year shall be entitled to all the privileges of the Association and shall be exempt from payment of a one-year annual fee.
